Kyoto, Japan

Kalesma

Mykonos, Greece

Once a favorite destination of artists and poets, the Greek island of Mykonos is primarily known for its summer party scene, but proving that the island has another side to it is the luxury boutique hotel Kalesma. The Aegean idyll, which is perfectly situated over Ornos Bay, opened in 2021 and has enveloped guests in classic Mykonian warmth and hospitality.
